


MASTER ROBERTO BAPTISTA



World Traditional KungFu Expert

Master (Sifu) **Roberto Baptista** began his apprenticeship in martial arts in 1972 in his home country Brazil when he was eight years old. He started practicing classical Judo (柔道) and made it his school sport until 1983 when he graduated from High School. In 1979 he was introduced to Gōjū-ryū (剛柔流), one of the main traditional Okinawan styles of Karate. Finally, in 1980 he was introduced to KungFu by a neighbor and immediately started his lifelong KungFu journey. He started his first formal **Northern Shaolin Kung Fu (北少林拳門 Běishǎolín Quánmén / Bak Siu Lum)** classes with Master Lee Chung Deh who was the second disciple of world-famous Master Chan Kwok Wai (Chén Guówěi 陳國偉), the father of KungFu in Brazil and the inheritor of one of the purest traditions of Chinese martial arts, Grand Master Chan Kwok Wai was one of the first authentic Chinese Masters to bring traditional KungFu to the Americas and accept non-Chinese students.

Master Lee Chung Deh's senior student Master Jorge J. Jung (one of the best traditional fighters of his generation) inspired Master Baptista's interest for traditional fighting skills. His discipline and dedication granted him to become a member of the training fighting group lead by Master Jorge J. Jung.


In 1990, after near ten years of dedicated practice, Master Baptista concluded his study of Northern Shaolin style KungFu, acquiring his first certification and becoming a first-generation graduate of Master Jorge J. Jung. His credentials were recognized and endorsed by the Brazilian Boxing Federation, being among the first KungFu Masters to receive an official certification from this renowned Brazilian sports organization.

Master Jorge W. Jung continually encouraged Master Baptista to deepen his studies and learn other styles of KungFu. Since January 1981, Master Baptista began deepening his knowledge of Northern Shaolin by learning directly from Grand Master Chan Kwok Wai at his world-renowned Sino Brazilian KungFu Academy in São Paulo – Brazil, becoming his direct student and acquiring certification under him after ten years of practice.





In 1988 Master Baptista also founded one of the first Brazilian state associations that led to the founding of the **Brazil KungFu Wushu Federation (CBKW)**. He was very active in the process of bringing recognition to KungFu Wushu as a legit sport in Brazil. Soon after its official recognition, Brazil KungFu Wushu Federation (CBKW) became the sole Brazilian entity affiliated to the recently founded **International Wushu Federation (IWUF)**.



In the early 1990's Master Baptista begun to travel abroad. His need to fulfill his calling and continue learning inspired him to travel to the United States to learn one of the oldest styles of Chinese Martial Arts, Shuaijiao (Chinese Wrestling). His Master, John S. Wang, was a direct disciple of the legendary Grand Master Chang *Tung Sheng*. After being certified by Master Wang through the American Combat Shuai-Chiao Association (ACSCA), Master Baptista became one of the first teachers of Shuaijiao in Brazil. One of his proud Baojin Shuaijiao students, Marcelo Antunes (PhD), has proceeded in his journey leads nationwide Shuaijiao and schools in Brazil to this day.

Master Baptista never lost an opportunity to improve his knowledge with many famous masters. He deepened his knowledge of TaiChi (*Taijiquan*) and TaiChi Sword (*Taijijian*) with late **Grand Master Wang Ju-Rong** – daughter of the renowned Grand Master Wang Zi-Ping. He also improved his knowledge of Chinna (*Qinna* 擒拿) with Master Yang Jwing-Ming and Master Liang Shou-Yu and made numerous trips to China to improve his knowledge.



In 1999 Master Baptista became a **Certified International Level Coach of Wushu** by the IWUF (international Wushu Federation) in Beijing – China, receiving instruction from several world-renown masters.




On the same occasion, two others masters from *Chan Kwok Wai*'s lineage were also certified: Master Thomaz Chan Hon Kit (GM *Chan Kwok Wai's* son) and late Master Nereu Graballos.

In the same decade Master Baptista also learned **Chen Taijiquan** (the original style of TaiChi) in China with **Master Chen Yinxu**, a direct descendent from the Chen family and direct disciple of Grand Master Chen Zhenglei (陈正雷) from Chenjiagou (Chen Village, 陳家溝).



Besides learning traditional and contemporary Chinese martial arts, Master Baptista also learned many traditional Qigong practices from his teachers, including Liangong (練功十八法).



Master Baptista was appointed to Member of the Technical Committee of the IWUF (international Wushu Federation), Beijing – China.






In March 2017, Master Baptista accepted an invitation from his KungFu nephew, Master Gus Rubio, to teach in the USA and moved with his family to Florida. In 2019 he became a permanent resident of the USA after being recognized as an Alien of Extraordinary Ability in the field of martial arts.

In 2019 Master Baptista was appointed to serve as **Vice-Chairman of Traditional KungFu for the United States of America Wushu KungFu Fede**ration (USAWKF) and serves in this role to this day.


Understanding the responsibility to preserve this priceless legacy transmitted through the ages from Master to Master and in **one on the most pure and au-thentic lineages in Chinese martial arts** history, Master Baptista opened his own school in Coral Springs, FL called **Kung Fu Connection**. He currently teaches and continues to pass down the traditional content that was preserved through his lineage.

- Received a Citation of a Brazilian State Government due to its contributions to the development of KungFu;
- Author of articles in US magazines; cited in KungFu-Wushu/Shuaijiao books and articles;
- Taught special seminars about Traditional KungFu in Brazil and in the USA;
- Invited by Master Gus Rubio's KungFu Connection, and moves to the USA in 2017 to be KungFu Connection Program Director and opens a new branch school in Coral Springs, FL;
- Served as National Judge during the 2017 USA Nationals (Lubbock, TX);
- Served as Vice-Chairman of the USAWKF selecting the US team to compete in the 2017 Traditional KungFu World Championship held on November 2017;
- Served as National Judge during the 2018 USA Nationals (Lubbock, TX); And served as Vice-Chairman of the USAWKF to select the US team to compete in the 2018 Juniors World Wushu Championship held on July 2018 (Brazil).
- Appointed as Vice Chairman of Traditional Chinese Martial Arts Committee of USAWKF - January 2019
- Served as Jury of Appeals during the 3rd Pan American Kungfu & Taijiquan Championships - July 2019
- Currently teaches Authentic Traditional Chinese Martial Arts at KungFu Connection in Coral Springs, FL.















